2012 Life Membership Corporate Meeting Highlights

Life Membership report from OLMF Annual Meeting in Minneapolis, MN July 7, 2012. Life Members by Region as of February 15, 2013:

The last Life Member number issued as of March 6, 2013 - "6818."

For the last OLMF fiscal year, 243 brothers became new Life Members. Last year we received over \$222,800 from the Fraternity. For the current fiscal year, we have received \$175,000 (two more months remain in this fiscal year).

- OLMF funds are managed by Brother Harry K. Ratliff, Vice President at Merrill Lynch.
- The total investment portfolio of OLMF is approximatel \$3.2 million dollars. The return on investment (ROI) in 2012 was 10.7 percent.

- OLMF received an unqualified opinion for the audit that was performed by the accounting firm of Thomas and Reed, LLC. The Foundation is compliant with IRS regulations.
- Over \$225,250 in scholarships, mentorship programs, talent hunt, licensing fees, and undergraduate activities provided.
- OLMF granted scholarships to the four Undergraduate members of the Supreme Council at \$40,000 per year (\$10,000 each).
- OLMF provided \$50,000 in mentorship grants in 2012 for Historically Black Colleges & Universities (HBCUs).
- A \$3,000 grant was issued to the Steve Harvey Mentoring Foundation in 2012.
- A \$3,000 grant was issued to the Clarence Lightner Achievers Program in 2012.
- The final installment of \$125,000 was provided to Howard University in 2012. This completes the \$250,000 grant to Howard University that was pledged during the 2011 Centennial Celebration.
- Emergency funds were provided to families in the 2nd and 9th regions that experienced damage due to Hurricanes Sandy and Isaac.
- A new interactive OLMF website was developed to make transactions, philanthropic giving, and access to information more user-friendly.

OLMF provides a grant to the 2012 Steve Harvey Mentoring Program



Dallas, TX - The goal of The Steve Harvey Mentoring Weekend is to break the misguided traits of manhood and introduce role models who provide positive examples of manhood.

"The Steve Harvey Mentoring Weekend for Young Men" is a four-day, three-night interactive program designed to share and teach the principles of manhood to young men between the ages of 13-18, who live in a single, female-head of household. This program helps these young men realize their potential and helps them to envision and prepare for a future where they are strong, responsible and productive men.

Since 2009 thousands of applications have been received for consideration and 300 teenage boys (100 boys per year) have participated in the Dallas mentoring weekend.

In 2011 "The Steve Harvey Regional Mentoring Programs" were launched in Los Angeles, New York, New Orleans and Atlanta. They were created in direct response to the pleas from parents & community leaders nationwide to help bring change to boys in their communities. This two-day experience introduces our core Dallas program to 100 young men in each city.

As part of the community outreach strategy, the Omega Life Membership Foundation Board of Directors awarded a \$3,000.00 grant to the Steve Harvey Foundation for its work in changing the lives of young men in the community.

OLMF supports the 2012 Clarence Lightner YMCA Achievers Program

Raleigh, NC - On November 13, 2012, the Research Triangle celebrated one of its most noted leaders, former Mayor Brother Clarence E. Lightner (Former OLMF Chairman), by honoring more than 100 teen leaders. The event was held at the Raleigh Marriott City Center Hotel.

The Omega Life Membership Foundation, The Sixth District, and the Iota Iota Chapter were among the corporate sponsors for the event. The annual banquet benefits Clarence E. Lightner YMCA Achievers, a leadership development program for area middle and high school students.

In July 2010, the YMCA of the Triangle Y Achievers Program and the Clarence E. Lightner Youth Leadership Foundation joined forces to improve the futures of teens in the Triangle region. The Lightner Foundation was established to provide leadership development programs aimed at making a positive impact on youth throughout the Triangle region.

The foundation also paid tribute to the life of Brother Clarence E. Lightener, the first and to date only African American mayor of Raleigh, NC by continuing his positive community efforts. Black Achievers, the parent program of the Y Achievers Program, was founded in 1971 at the Harlem YMCA. Its purpose was to help teens develop a positive sense of self and to set high education and career goals.

The keynote speaker for the event was former YMCA of the Triangle Area (YOTA) swimmer and 2012 Olympic Gold Medalist Charlie Houchin.




















Omega Life Membership Foundation, Inc. Annual Corporate Meeting Details August 1, 2013
